JUST FOR CHILDREN

We welcome your children to the Sunday school of Moody Memorial and we welcome you as partners in our ministry with children. We take seriously the task of making Christ and the Christian story known to children in a manner that nurtures them in their lifelong growth in faith. It is our belief that home and church must become partners in nurturing children in their Christian growth.

The children's Sunday school classes use a very interactive curriculum of games, stories, art and drama. This curriculum includes age-appropriate Bible stories from the Old and New Testaments. SCHOOL AGE CLASSES

On Sunday mornings, school age children meet in the Multi-Ministry Room for Anchor Time from 9:30 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Anchor Time is followed by a rotation model of Sunday school with stories, art and games. After class, children return to the Multi-Ministry Room where they rejoin their families.

ADULT CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Christian education classes for adults are held every Sunday throughout the year at 9:30 a.m. Following are the descriptions of each class and their locations. AGAPE *PARLOR*

The Agape class is a large adult class that studies a wide variety of topics. The class is lecture format with group discussion. Members of this class are very active in fellowship and outreach. Age 55 and over.

ASBURY *ROOM R421*

This class emphasizes fellowship and Christian friendship. The lesson format explores available literature and video material as a springboard to discussion of religious, moral, and ethical issues. The video format allows the class exposure to some of the greatest theologians of our time and extraordinary historical perspectives on religious history. Open to all adults.

THE GOOD NEWS CLASS *ROOM G332*

The Good News class is an active group that gathers for fellowship, support, prayer and Bible study. The class studies the Bible to refresh their faith in God and to create a deeper understanding of how to serve God in today's fast-paced world. Age range is 25-45.

METHODISM 101 *ROOM B211*

Whether you are a long time Methodist or a visitor, this adult class is an opportunity to learn more about United Methodism. It is a discussion class on the beliefs, traditions, customs and other United Methodist issues. The class is taught primarily by our Senior Pastor, Rev. Bert Bagley.

OPEN DOOR *ROOM B203*

This is a large class that welcomes visitors and new members. We rely on insights and opinions from all members and most of our learning comes from their input. We encourage sharing and want to create an environment of friendship and support. Bill Glenn is teaching this group discussion class. An important focus for this group is to be active in outreach mission work. Open to all ages.

SERENDIPITY *ROOM R435*

This adult singles class studies life's lessons, using Biblical and spiritual guideposts through fellowship and discussion with an occasional guest speaker. Emphasis is on strengthening the spiritual lives of single adults, building faith and sharing fellowship. They also sponsor a non-denominational singles group, Soltero, that gathers for social activities. Open to all ages.

WESLEY *ROOM B209*

The Wesley Class focuses on topical Bible study with an emphasis on group discussion and participation. Topics vary as class interest varies. The members of this class are very active in our church fellowship and outreach. Current leader for the class is Jeff Rabek. Open to all ages.

HISPANIC ADULTS *ROOM R427*

The Adult Spanish Language Sunday School Class is held at 10:00 a.m. followed by the 11:00 a.m. worship in Fellowship Hall. The class uses the quarterly Lecciones Christianas as the basis for study.

DISCIPLE BIBLE STUDY

The DISCIPLE Bible Study program is designed to develop strong Christian leaders through the in-depth study of Scripture. Through DISCIPLE, participants will be strengthened in their faith and guided into service and ministry. We currently have Disciple I, Disciple II, and a Hispanic Disciple study.

YOUNG ADULTS

GENESIS *ROOM B213*

This class is for young working adults and graduate students class meets weekly at 9:45 a.m. It is a Scripture based, discussion oriented class led by Brian Quigley. Age range is 20 - 35.

CAMPUS & YOUNG ADULTS *ROOM R437*

On Thursday evenings during the fall and spring semesters, join students and other young adults in this discussion oriented class. Based on Scripture, this class explores a wide variety of topics that are of particular interest to young adults. Rev. Mark Fleming, our Wesley Campus minister, will coordinate and co-teach this class.
